Particulars of station marking and beacon:

3/4" diameter copper tube inserted in 1/2" diameter G.I. pipe. Mast set in concrete block which is marked with the station number.

Beacon: Nil.

REFERENCE MARKS.

Three 1/2" diameter copper tubes set in concrete blocks which have been re-inforced with steel pickets set directly below the copper tubes. One steel Witness Post, one red painted blaze on a tree (eucalypt) and a red painted triangle on a telegraph pole.

ACCESS.

NM/C/80 is sited close to the north side of the Walgett - Brewarrina road, 14.4 miles west of Walgett. It was so close to see to the road bend 3.9 miles east, and west along the narrow clearing of the telephone line for about 4 miles.

Views are restricted in all directions otherwise from 300 ft tower was needed for all observations and measurements. A 12" diameter trench was dug around the station mark.

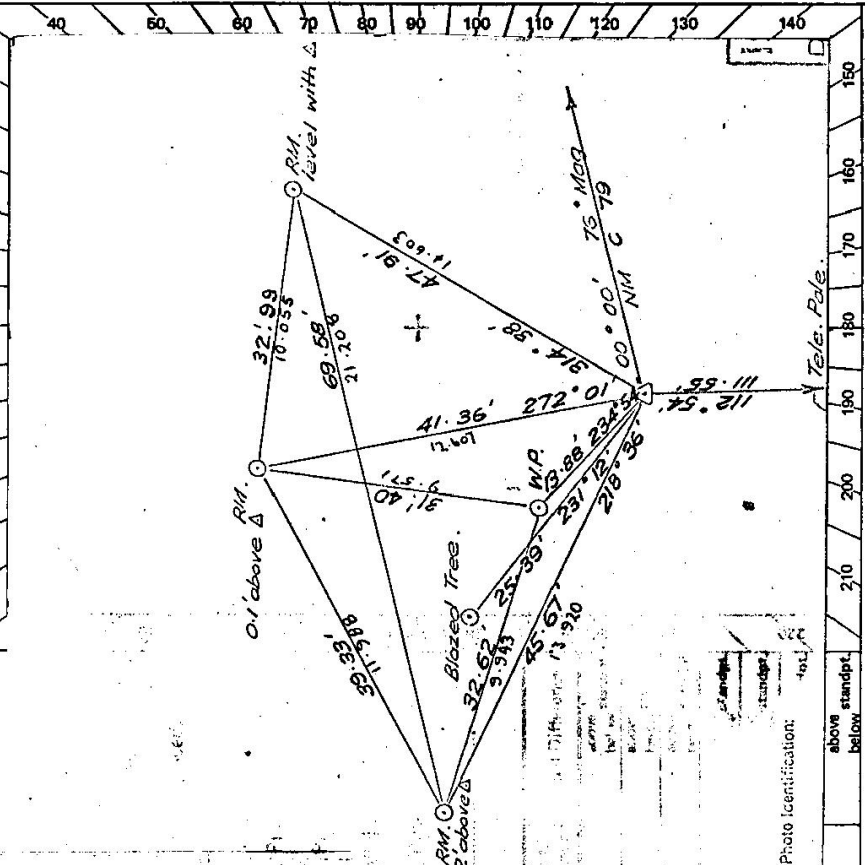
